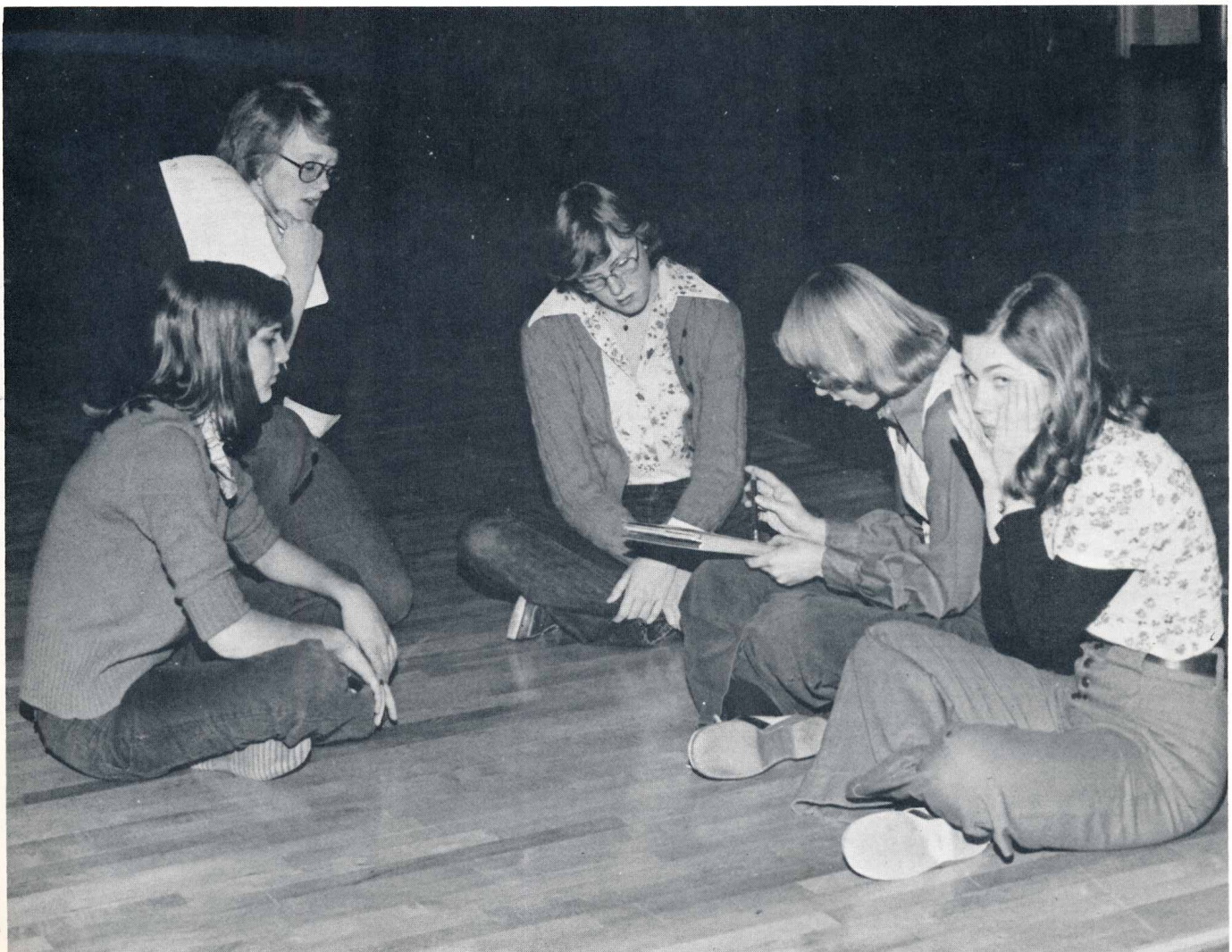
Staff Message

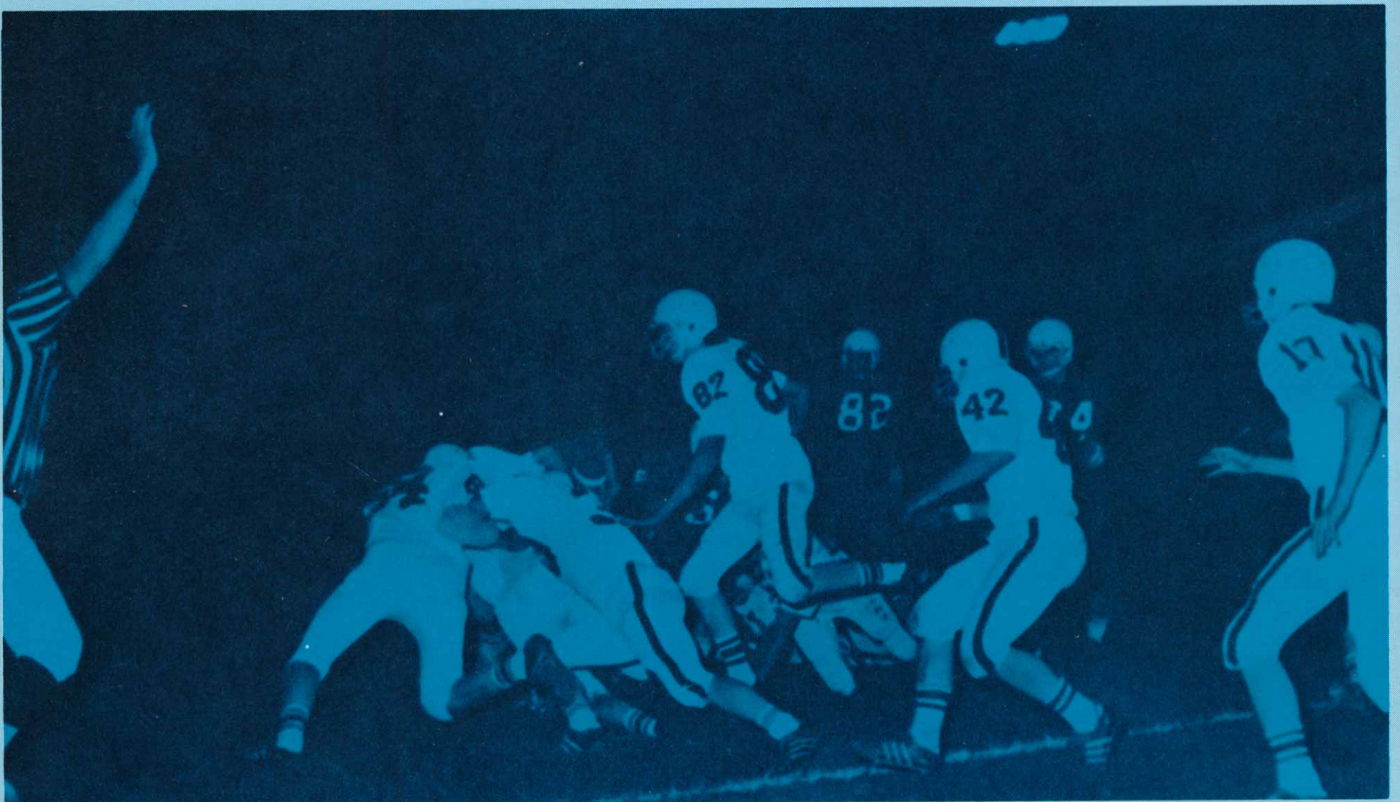
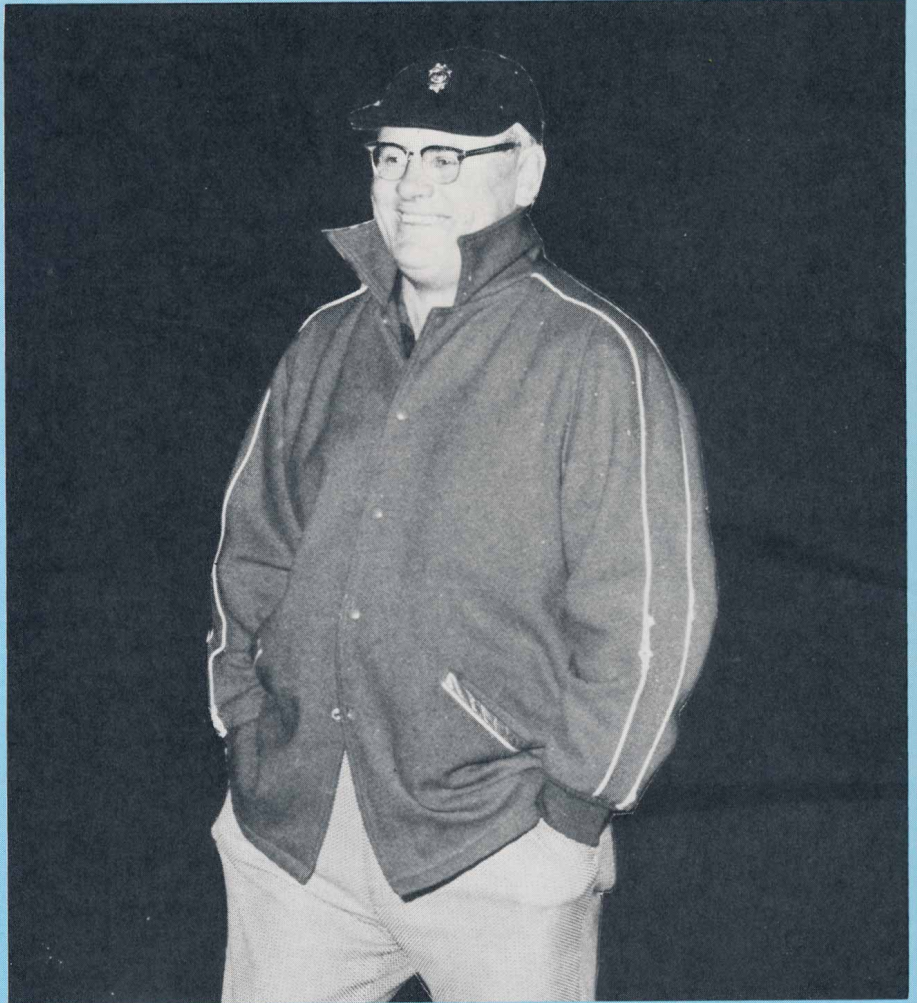
The first section of this book is a play by play account of the school year, by seasons. We hope this section, and the whole book will bring back fond memories in the future of the "74-75" school year.

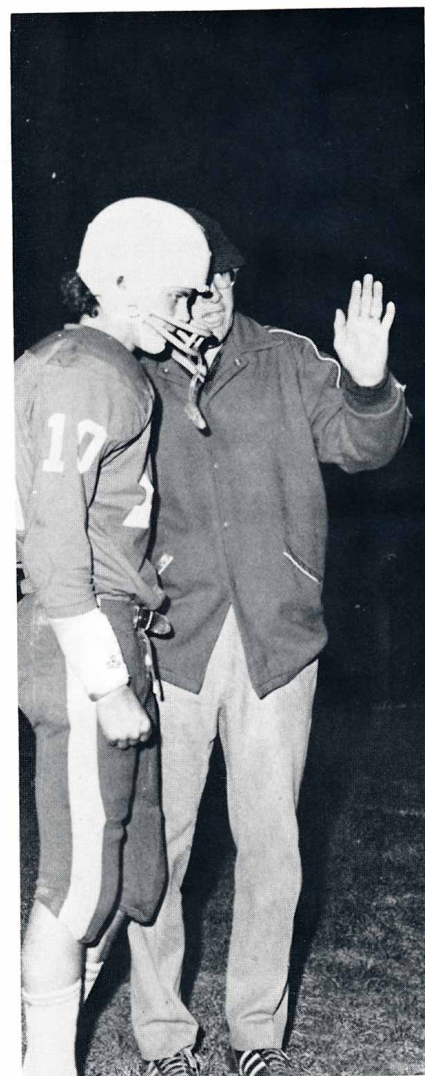
The 1974 football season was not one of Luck's best. The Cards lost 5 games and won only 3. John Stenberg was named "Most Valuable Player."

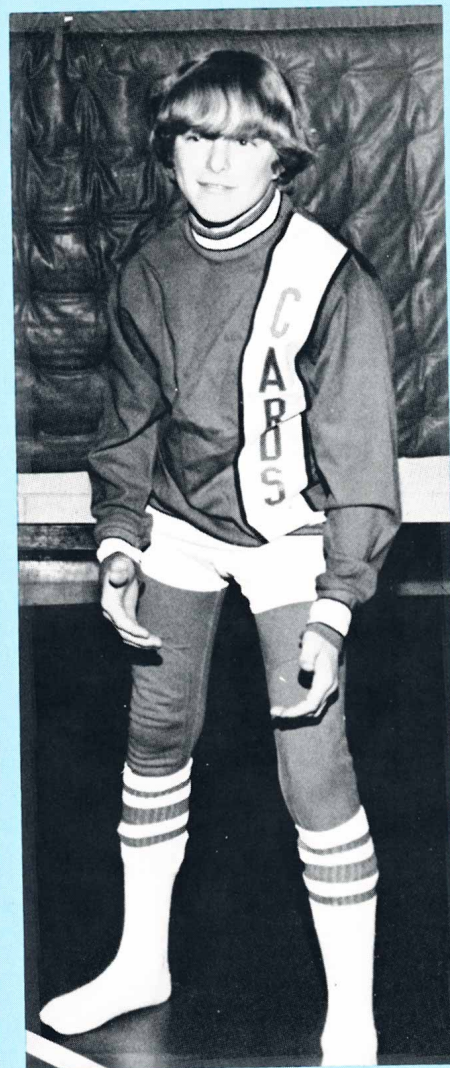
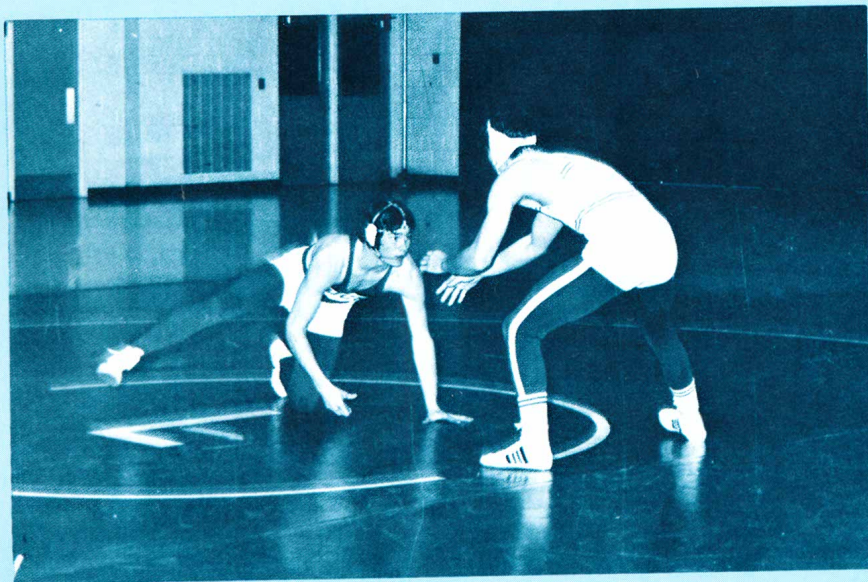


Wrestling Squad

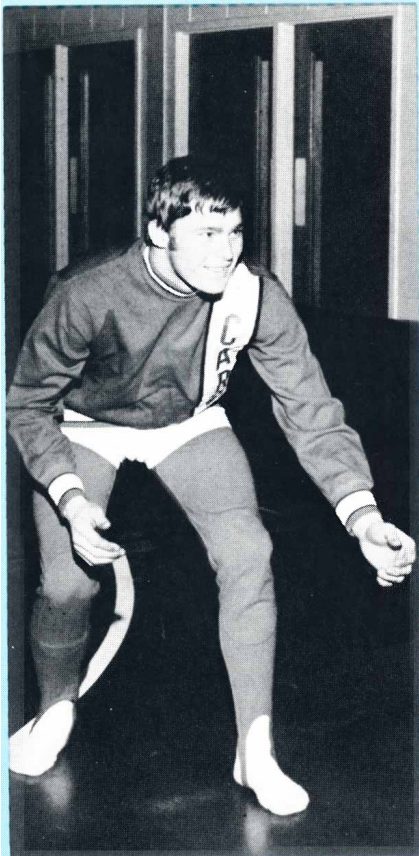

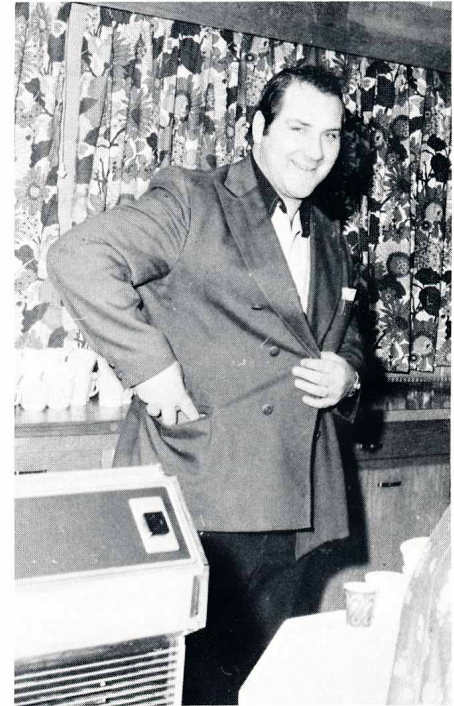
The Luck Band, Core Choir and Choir performed at the Christmas Concert for the benefit of many on December 15. Mr. Nygren directed the entire program.

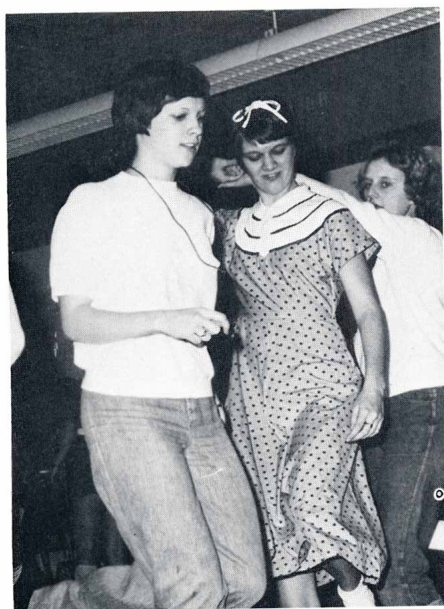


On December 18, the annual F.H.A. Christmas Tea was given by the girls and Mrs. Winchell. It was a huge success.

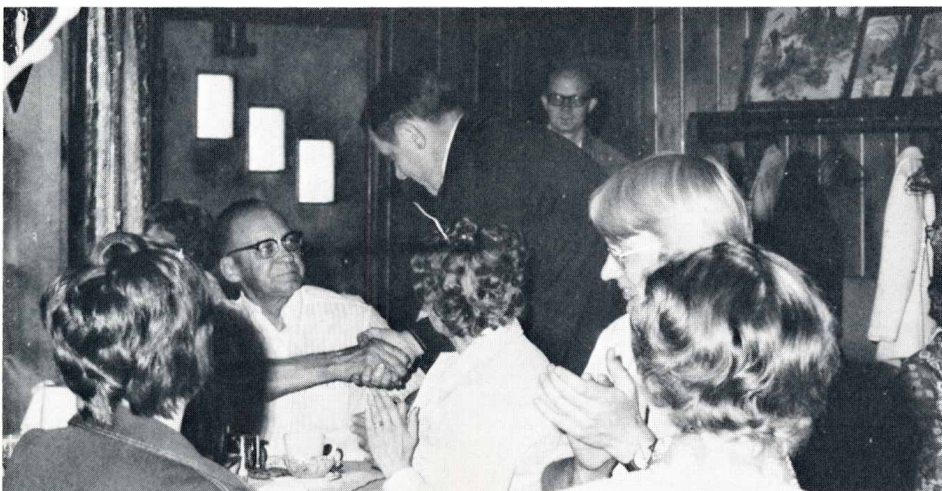
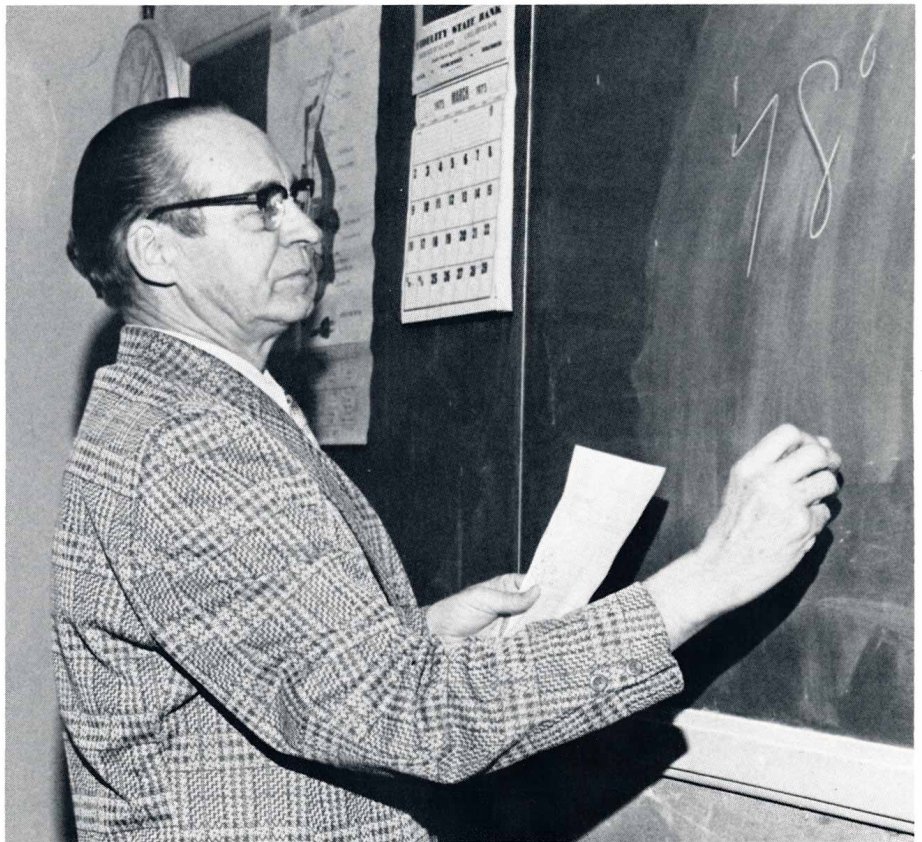


Farewell to Mr. Olson

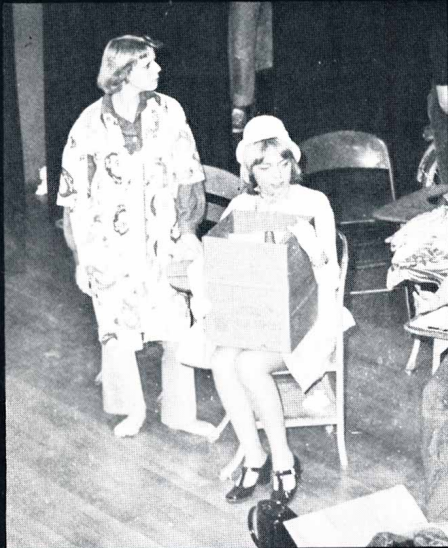

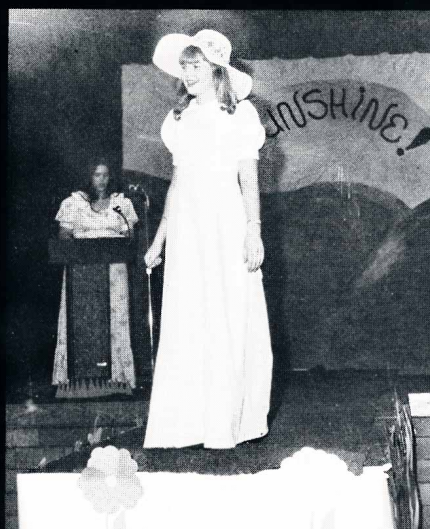
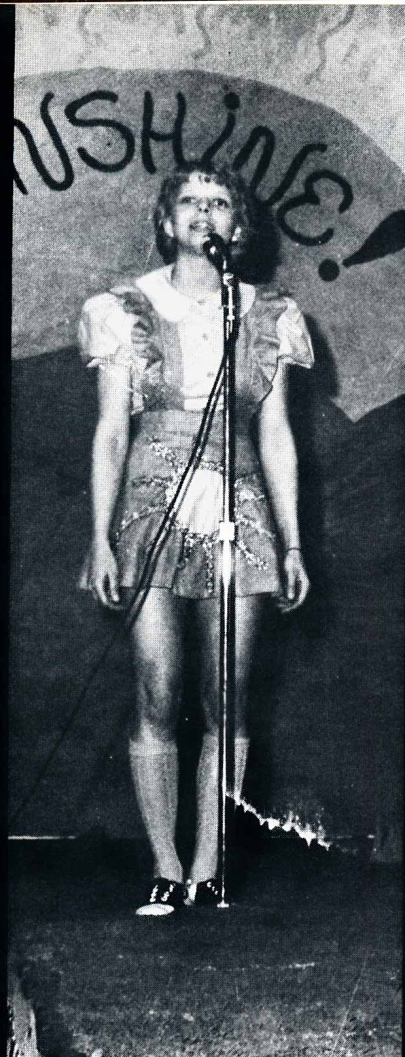

Style Show

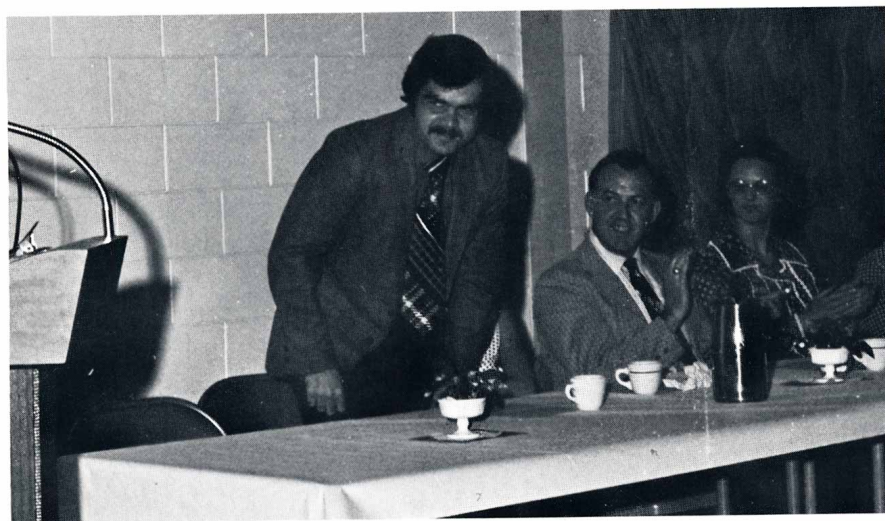

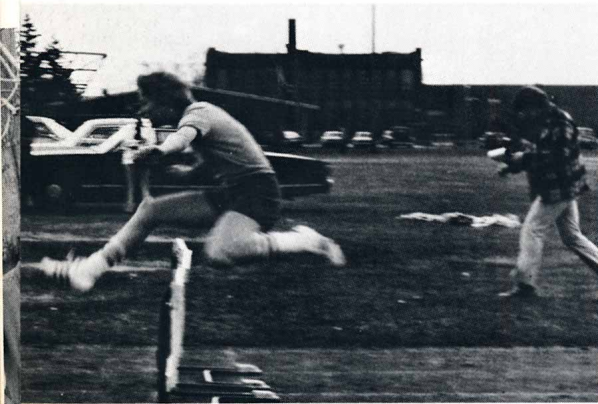


Girls Track and Field

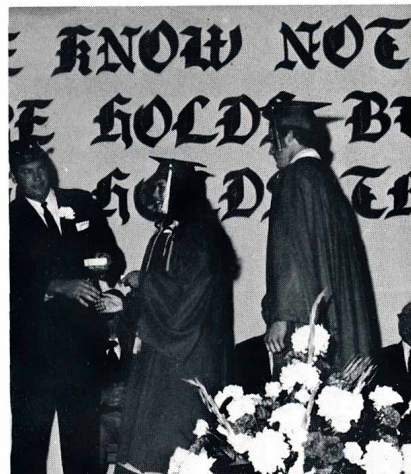
Lester "Jocko" Everts
